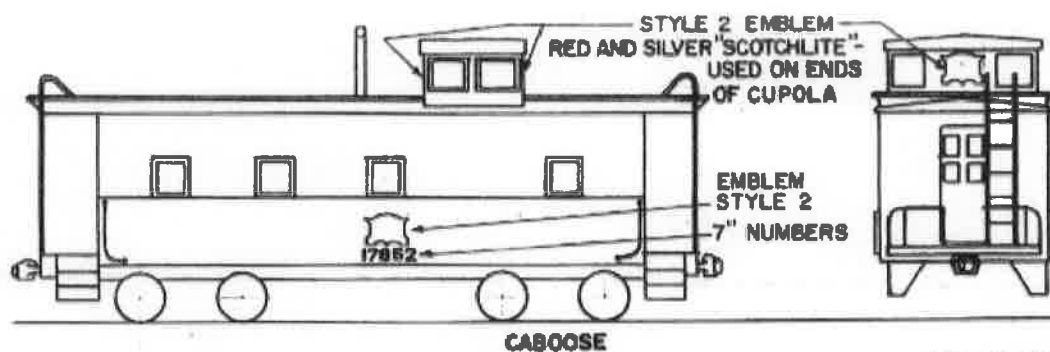
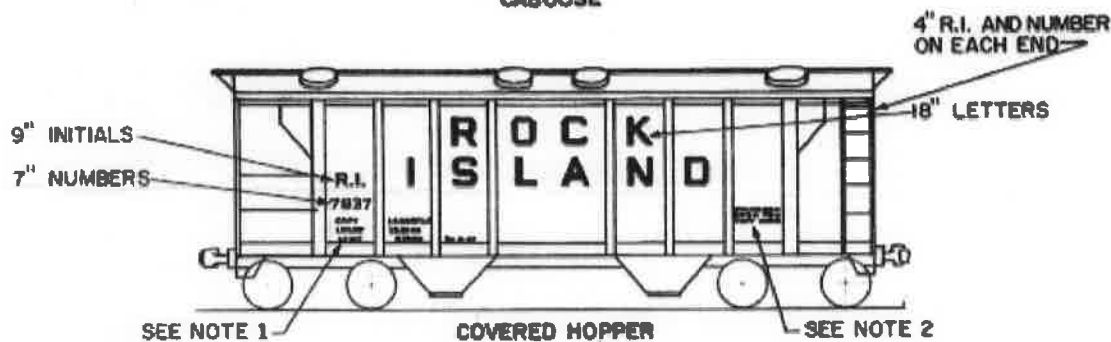


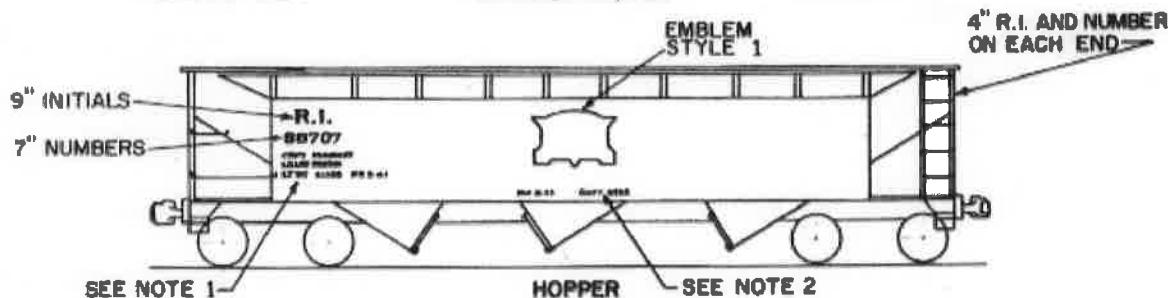

GENERAL NOTES

PAINTING: ALL CARS FREIGHT CAR RED EXCEPT COVERED HOPPERS-GRAY, AND CABOOSES-LIGHT RED
STENCILLING: WHITE, EXCEPT BLACK ON COVERED HOPPERS. LETTERS AND NUMBERS ARE HEAVY BLOCK STYLE

ARRANGEMENTS SHOWN ARE TYPICAL ONLY, AND ARE VARIED TO SUIT DIFFERENT CAR CONSTRUCTION. GENERALLY THE EMBLEM IS USED ON CARS HAVING A BROAD, FLAT AREA ON THE SIDES, WHILE CARS WITH OUTSIDE POSTS ARE STENCILLED **ROCK ISLAND**, WITH THE LETTERS SPACED TO CLEAR THE POSTS.

THE FOLLOWING DATA STENCILLING IS USED ON ALL CARS EXCEPT CABOOSES:

LOADING DATA: (3" LETTERS AND FIGURES, 3" SPACES BETWEEN LINES)
 CAPY 140000 HT ----- (RATED CAPACITY AND A.A.R. CLASSIFICATION OF CAR)
 LDLMT 159000 ----- (MAXIMUM LOAD CAR IS PERMITTED TO CARRY)
 LT WT 51500 SV12-63 ----- (EMPTY WEIGHT OF CAR, STATION AND DATE LAST WEIGHED)
