WHEREAS, The City of Cotter understands Federal-aid Recreational Trails Program Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match/in kind labor to develop or improve The Big Spring Walking Tail starting at the pavilion, and

WHEREAS, The City of Cotter understands that Federal-aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement, and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the applicant for the life of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the City Council of the City of Cotter THAT:

SECTION I: The City of Cotter will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility, including maintenance of this project.

SECTION II: The City of Cotter, Mayor McGeorge Caradine is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the above stated project.

SECTION III: The Cotter City Council pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas Department of Transportation to initiate action to implement this project.

SECTION IV: This resolution will supersede all wording used in Resolution 2021-07 as the grantor requires its own verbiage to be used throughout the application process.
