

ORDINANCE NO. 95-07

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS, EXCEPT DURING THE PERIODS OF JUNE 25 THROUGH JULY 5, OF EACH YEAR AND IN A DESIGNATED AREA ONLY, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Except during the periods of June 25 through July 5, of each year, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to shoot, explode, discharge, fire, or set off any type of fireworks within the corporate limits of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, except in an area designated by the City Council, without first obtaining a written permit therefore.

SECTION 2. Application for permit shall be made in writing to the City Council of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, setting forth the place, date, time and purpose for the shooting, exploding, discharging, firing or setting off of fireworks and, if same meets with approval of the City Council of said City, said Council shall direct the City Recorder to issue written permit therefore.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be fined in a sum of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$200.00 for each and every violation.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Whereas this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the health and safety of the citizens of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, and an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect for and after its passage.
