## RESOLUTION #2018-09

### **A RESOLUTION NAMING THE COTTER-GASSVILLE JOINT SEWER COMMISSION AS THE ENTITY TO APPLY FOR FUNDS FROM FEDERAL AND STATE AGENCIES FOR "PHASE II" A REHABILITATION OF THE WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM.**

**WHEREAS:** The Cotter-Gassville Joint Sewer Commission has received funds (loans) for emergency repairs to the collection system from the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission (ANRC) in 2018; and

**WHEREAS:** Following a meeting with a federal agency, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Services, it was determined a sole entity would need to be recognized on behalf of the cities for the application process to continue for federal and state agency purposes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:**

**Section 1:** The Cotter-Gassville Joint Sewer Commission (and the Chair thereof) is hereby recognized and authorized by the City Council of Cotter, Arkansas, as the entity to apply for state and federal funding for the completion of Phase II rehabilitation to the wastewater collection system.

**Section 2:** That Gassville City Attorney Ron Kincade will consult with Cotter City Attorney Roger Morgan as needed regarding the application process including review of any possible loans, bonded debt, including recommendation of bond attorney and all legal aspects required of state and federal agencies for funding.

**Section 3:** The Cotter- Gassville Joint Sewer Commission recognizes that it will be the entity during the application process and funding only any and all grants/loans for the system are to be approved by the City Council of Cotter, Arkansas.
