

RESOLUTION #2020-14

City Council of Cotter, Arkansas

A Resolution to apply for an Arkansas Preservation Restoration Grant for the North Arkansas Youth Center.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Cotter, Arkansas, authorizes the Mayor of Cotter, Arkansas to apply for a grant on behalf of the North Arkansas Youth Center;

WHEREAS, the City of Cotter, Arkansas has determined that North Arkansas Youth Center meets the eligibility requirements as being on the National Register of Historic Places which is necessary to apply for a grant under the Arkansas Historic Preservation Restoration Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the City of Cotter, Arkansas recognizes the need for funding to correct environmental and structural deficiencies: by replacing the asphalt shingles keeping moisture out of the building, and correcting conditions to remove bat guano that may pose a safety hazard to the building occupants, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor of Cotter, Arkansas, is hereby authorized to submit a letter of intent by November 13, 2020, to make an application of formal request to the Arkansas Historic Preservation Grant Program by March 15, 2021, for the purpose of securing state 50/50 grant funds to aid and assist the City of Cotter in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Mayor of Cotter, Arkansas, is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.
