During information, Mayor Caradine shared that the advertising for bids for Sanitary Sewer Collection System Phase II improvement is being advertised in the Arkansas Gazette and bids will be opened on July 13, 2023, at 10:00 am at Cotter City Hall Plans available for viewing at the Cotter City Hall. The ARPA funds received in 2021 are being used to provide a new pump building, pressure pump and piping at the Highway Tank should be approved by the Department of Health within the 30 days, followed by request for bids from ESI Engineers. Arkansas Legislative Auditor completed Cotter's General 2022 Audit and the report shall be submitted to the Legislative Committee for approval. The 2022 Water and Sewer Rate study is being performed by the Arkansas Rural Water Association. On July 6th and 7th, Britney Sellers with Scoffer Studios Production will be shooting a final movie scene in Big Spring Park.
