Resolution 2024-05: A Resolution to apply for the Arkansas Rural Community Grant Program

Be it resolved by the City Council of Cotter, State of Arkansas a resolution entitled: A Resolution to approve the Mayor of the City of Cotter to apply for an Arkansas Rural Community Grant for the purpose of the addition of 13 bollard lights and 2 flood lights along the Big Spring Park Nature Trail.

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor of Cotter, Arkansas to apply for a grant on behalf of the City of Cotter.

WHEREAS, the Cotter City Council has determined that the City of Cotter meets eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a grant under the Arkansas Rural Community Grant Programs, and

WHEREAS, the Cotter Community has presented plans for City Park improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Cotter recognizes the need for the project, concurs its importance, and supports the Cotter Community in its efforts to proceed with the same, and

WHEREAS, the City of Cotter has furnished proof that they have raised \$28,500.00 through community cash and/or in-kind donations to be applied to the project as a local match;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of Cotter hereby appropriates a sum of up to \$28,500.00 to complete the local match money requirement for the project described herein;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor of Cotter is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Rural Development Commission for purpose of securing state grant funds in the amount of \$15,000.00 to aid and assist the Cotter Community in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Mayor or Recorder/Treasurer of Cotter is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.
